

DeKalb County School District WBL Admissions Requirements

Students must have parental/guardian approval to apply to WBL and the parent must understand the admission requirements outlined below:

- Students must be responsible, mature, respectful, and have integrity.
- Students must be willing to work as a paid or unpaid intern or employee.
- Students must be willing to submit all weekly/monthly paperwork.
- Students must have at least a 2.0 GPA and be on track for graduation.
- Students must not have any disciplinary issues (OSS and ISS) from the current and/or previous school year.
- Students must have good attendance and tardies (15 or fewer unexcused in both).
- Students must have room in their schedule to accommodate having either 1, 2, or 3 consecutive periods/blocks of the WBL Class.
- Students/parents must provide daily transportation to and from their placements. Students/parents understand students must leave campus at the beginning of their first WBL class, even if they are not scheduled to work.
- All employers must agree to participate as a WBL placement partner and complete and sign all requested documentation.

Students must apply and be approved by the WBL Coordinator. The WBL Coordinator reserves the right to approve students based on the totality of the student's academic, behavior, and attendance record.
